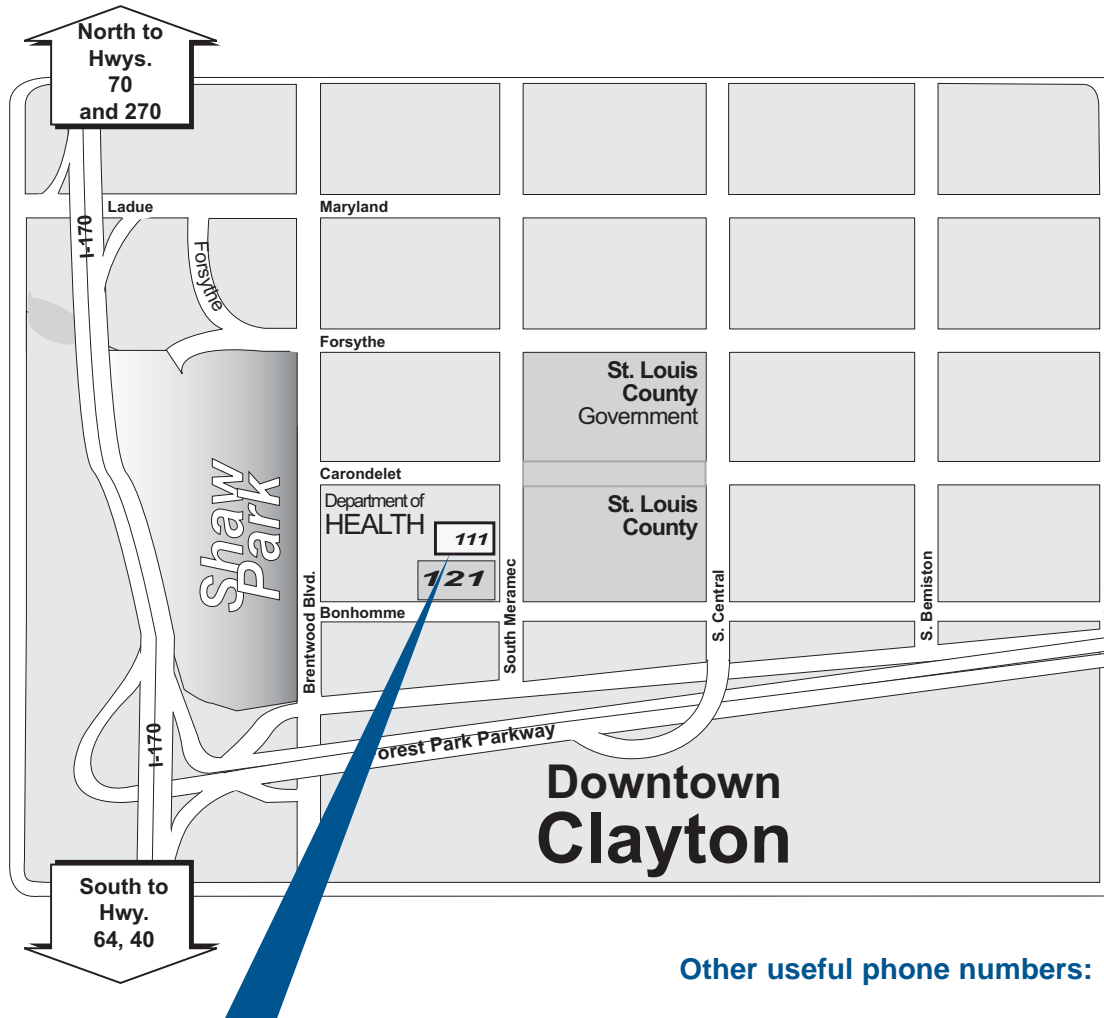

Saint Louis County Office of Vital Records issues certified copies of birth and death certificates for most events that occurred inside the state of Missouri. The years that are available for birth are 1920 to the present, and for death 1980 to present. However, any death that occurred prior to 1980 is available only if the event took place inside St. Louis County.

A certified copy of a birth or death record may be obtained by sending a written request to:

Include the following information:

- Full name
- Date of birth or death
- Hospital where birth or death occurred
- Your relationship to the individual on the record
- The purpose for the copies
- For birth records, also include father's name and mother's maiden name.

Birth records cost \$15/copy. Death records are \$13 for the first copy and \$10 each for additional copies of the same record ordered at the same time. Make checks payable to Vital Records. Please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope and allow two weeks for processing time by mail.

Same-day service is available Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. You must present identification when making requests in person.

The Vital Records Office in the City of Saint Louis has records of births and deaths since 1853, for events which occurred inside the City of Saint Louis.

The State Vital Records Office in Jefferson City, MO, has records for the State of Missouri since 1910, when it became a law that all such documents had to be recorded.

The Saint Louis County Courthouse has records of marriages and divorces. Marriage records are at the Recorder of Deeds Office. Divorce records are in the Circuit Clerk's Office. The address is 7900 Carondelet, Clayton, MO 63105. The phone number for the Saint Louis County Courthouse is (314) 615-5000.

Immigration and Naturalization Services are at the U.S. Customs House in the City of Saint Louis. Their address is 1222 Spruce Street, Saint Louis, MO 63103. The phone number is (314) 539-2532.
