**The purpose of Saint Louis County's Dental Health Services** is to assure quality dental care for all County residents. Good oral health for each and every individual is our goal. Here are some commonly asked questions about Saint Louis County's dental health services.

### **Who is eligible for treatment at the County's dental offices?**

The County's dental offices are open to every Saint Louis County resident.

### **Are there any financial requirements?**

There is a sliding-fee scale, based on the income of the family and the number of people in the household. Fees are charged according to where you are on the scale. You might pay from 0% to 100% of the full charge.

### **What services do you provide?**

- Examinations
- X-rays
- Cleanings (Prophylaxis)
- Limited periodontal treatment
- Fluoride treatments
- Oral hygiene instructions
- Sealants
- Fillings
- Extractions (Uncomplicated)
- Root canals (Limited)

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### **What services are not provided?**

- Gold inlays
- Crowns (Caps) and bridges
- Partial and full dentures
- Denture relines and repairs
- Complicated extractions
- Complicated root canals
- Orthodontics (Braces)
- Periodontal surgery
