

## APPRENTICE PLUMBER REGISTRATION

PLUMBERS APPRENTICESHIP - A person desiring to learn the plumbing trade may register as an apprentice plumber under the following condition:

1. An applicant for Plumbers Apprentice Registration shall:
  - a. Be associated with a licensed Master Plumber and be currently receiving on-job-training under the personal direction and supervision of a St Louis County, Missouri licensed Master or Journeyman Plumber.
  2. Register with the Board. Said registration shall include an application with the applicant's name, social security number, address, zip code, age and telephone number. The applicant shall also include on the application the name of the licensed Master Plumber under which the applicant will be receiving training and instructions..
  3. Applicant must furnish a letter from said Licensed Master Plumber verifying employment and listing the names and license numbers of all journeyman and apprentice currently in his employ.
  4. Applicant will pay a one time registration fee of ten dollars (\$10.00).
  5. Applicant will have his picture taken by digital camera in the Plumbing License Office located @ 41 So. Central, 6<sup>th</sup> fl, Clayton MO 63105.
  6. Applicant shall be required to attend a meeting of the Board of Plumber & Drainlayer Examiners when application has been approved.
2. Plumbers apprentices shall, during the first month of each year after registration, report training and employment status to the Board. Such report shall be on a form provided by the Board. It shall list for the past year, employers, and length of time worked. Failure to report this required information to the Board of Plumber and Drainlayer Examiners may cause the registration to be canceled.
3. Any Master Plumber employing an apprentice shall advise the Board in writing immediately upon the commencement or termination of the apprentice's employment.
4. The number of plumber apprentices employed by a Master Plumber at any given time shall not exceed the total number of licensed Journeyman and Master Plumbers employed at that time.
