#### Section 107.071 SLCRO:

- Establishes the St. Louis County Minority and Women Business Enterprise Program

### Certification as M/WBE

- Two Options:

### Construction Subcontract Goals:

24% MBE

9.5% WBE

### Additional M/WBE Program Elements

#### Bid Discount

- Applied to prime contracts for construction, supplies, and contractual services of \$300,000 or less
- Applied during evaluation; resulting contract is for full amount bid
- Must include proof of certification

### Additional M/WBE Program Elements

#### Incentive Credit

- Applied to professional service prime contracts
- 15% credit is applied through evaluation
- Must include proof of certification
