

Volunteer Opportunities

For older and younger adults, looking for productive and beneficial ways to fill free time. Training is provided for all volunteers.

Neighbor Driving Neighbor: Transport older adults to and from medical appointments and other essential trips.

Care Calls: Call a homebound adult regularly to check on their well-being or visit them in their home to chat, read, play a game or just be a friend.

Attorney, Paralegal, Notary:

Provide non-litigation assistance.

Income Tax Preparer:

Prepare state, federal and MO-PTC forms.

Forms Assistance: Assist with the preparation of medical claims forms.

Office Assistant: Answer phones, maintain files, work on computers, help with mailings.

Community Outreach: Represent CORP at community festivals and fairs.

Several CORP programs and projects highlight **Active Aging**, including computer and other special interest clubs. The song and dance revue "Broadway Fantasies" features the musical talents of older adults.

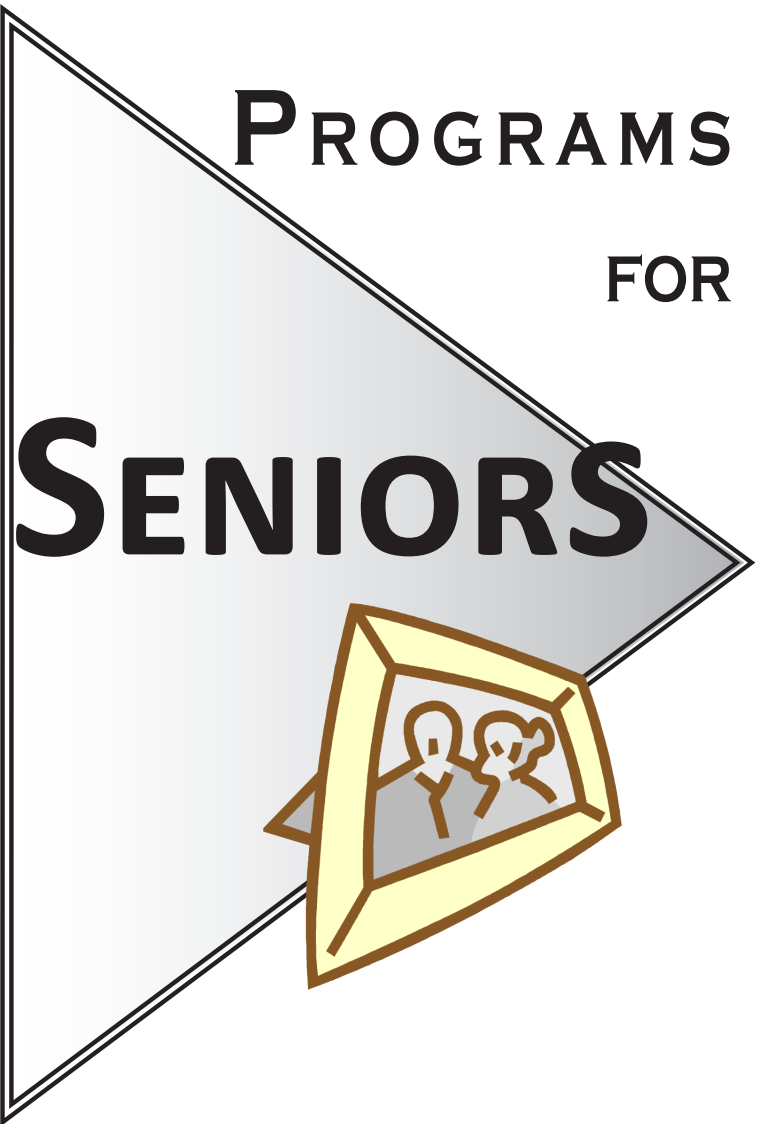

MISSOURI PROPERTY TAX CREDIT CLAIM MO-PTC (CIRCUIT BREAKER)

Partial refund (by check) of paid real estate taxes up to a maximum of \$1,100 for owners, \$750 for renters who rent from a facility that pays property taxes. Eligible nursing home residents may file as renters.

Income guidelines may be subject to change.

**To qualify for the program,
you or your spouse must meet one of the
following criteria:**

- 65 or older as of 12/31/2018 and a Missouri resident the entire year; **OR**
- 100 percent disabled; **OR**
- 60 as of 12/31/2018 and receiving surviving spouse social security benefits

Annual Income Limit (2016, 2017 & 2018)

Single:

\$27,500 if rented or owned less than full year;
\$30,000 if owned & occupied entire year.

Married and filing combined:

\$29,500 if rented or owned less than full year;
\$34,000 if owned & occupied entire year.

The MO-PTC is generally filed with the income tax return, but may be filed at any time during the year for up to three years back.

Example:

In 2019 you may file for 2016, 2017 & 2018.

**The State of Missouri is the sole program
administrator of the MO-PTC.**

County Older Resident Programs (CORP)

Provides a variety of programs, services and volunteer opportunities for St. Louis County residents age 60 and older.

Neighbor Driving Neighbor: Volunteers use their own vehicles to transport older adults to medical appointments and other essential business.

Care Calls: Volunteers call homebound older adults regularly to check on their well-being or visit them in their home.

Legal Assistance: Volunteer attorneys prepare simple wills, quit claim deeds, and other legal documents.

Tax Preparation: Trained volunteers prepare state and federal tax forms in season; ***provide year-round assistance with the MO-PTC.***

Forms Assistance: Trained volunteers help to complete medical and insurance claim forms.

Home Care and Repair: CORP brokers home care and repair services provided by experienced workers who must be approved after a St. Louis County Police record check.

Services include referrals for minor home repair jobs and homemaker/chore services.

Age Smart, Age Well: The Aging Services Academy offers classes in gerontology and successful aging along with basic computer skills classes in Windows, Word, Internet and e-mail.

Information & Referral: Referrals to additional community services.
